OUR PRAYER



“Mantra is not a mere collection of words. It is a compounded set of words with enormous significance. It emanates from the inner power of man. Filled with such power, the mantra, when it is pronounced properly, brings out the divine power in man. The vibrations produced by the utterance of the mantra, uniting with the cosmic nāda (primal sound) in the universe, become one with the Universal Consciousness. It is these cosmic vibrations, which assumed the form of the Veda (sacred revelations of spiritual knowledge).”

[Sathya Sai Speaks, vol 17.25: October, 01, 1984]

The Gayatri mantra is a universal prayer enshrined in the Vedas. It is addressed to the Immanent and Transcendent Divine which has been given the name 'Savita,' meaning 'that from which all this is born.' The Gayatri may be considered as having three parts - (i) Adoration (ii) Meditation (iii) Prayer. First, the Divine is praised, then It is meditated upon in reverence and finally, an appeal is made to the Divine to awaken and strengthen the intellect, the discriminating faculty of man.

The Gayatri is considered as the essence of the Vedas. Veda means knowledge, and this prayer fosters and sharpens the knowledge-yielding faculty. As a matter of fact, the four core-declarations enshrined in the four Vedas are implied in this Gayatri mantra.

Om bhur bhuvah svah |
Om tat savitur Varenyam |
Bhargo devasya dhimahi |
Dhiyo yo nah prachodayat |

Gayatri mantra originated with the creation of earth. It is a sacred mantra. Lord Brahma, Creator of the universe, got this mantra from divine voice (i.e. Aakashvani). It is said that, because of this mantra, Lord Brahma got the Power of creation.

Gayatri mantra is described as having five faces. The first is "Om". The second is "Bhur-bhuvah-svah". The third is. "Tat-savitur Vareṇyaṃ". The fourth is "Bhargo Devasya Dhīmahi". The fifth is "Dhiyo Yonah Prachodayāt".

Gayatri mantra is represented in these five phases and the five prāṇas (life forces). Gayatri is the protector of the five prāṇas in man. "Gāyantam trāyate iti Gayatri" -- Because it protects the one who recites it, it is called Gayatri. When Gayatri acts as protector of the life-forces, she is known as Savitri. Savitri is known in the scripted story as the devoted wife who brought back to life her husband, Sathyavan. Savitri is the presiding deity of the five prāṇas. She protects those who lead a life of Truth. This is the inner meaning.

When one's intelligence and intuition are developed by the recitation of the mantra, the activating deity is Gayatri. When the life-forces are protected, the guardian deity is called Savitri. When one's speech is protected, the deity is called Saraswati. Because of the protective roles of Savitri, Saraswati and Gayatri, in relation to life, speech, and the intellect, Gayatri is described as "Sarva-devatā-swarūpiṇi"--- the embodiment of all goddesses.

The Gayatri mantra has three parts: 1. Praise, 2. Meditation, and 3. Prayer. First, the Divine is praised, then it is meditated upon in reverence and lastly, an appeal is made to the Divine to dispel the darkness of ignorance and to awaken and strengthen the intellect. Dhīmahi is related to the meditative aspect. Dhīyo Yonah Prachodayāt relates to the aspect of prayer. Chanting of the Gayatri Mantra purifies the mind and confers devotion, detachment and wisdom.

ALL ABOUT THE BAJSS WOMEN'S COLLEGE:

The Bharatiya Adima Jaati Sevak Sangh® in short BAJSS is all India level voluntary organization registered in the year 1949–50 at New Delhi.

The objectives of the BAJSS is the work for the Socio-economic and educational advance of the Adima Jaati (Primitive and Aboriginal tribes) communities and weaker sections including Nomadic and De-notified (Vimukta) tribes, from the academic year 1979-80 in India. A view to enable them to take their legitimate place in the National life as equal citizens. It has expanded its educational activities throughout the country till date.

A local committee formed by the authorities of all India BAJSS have started BAJSS Arts and Commerce College for women, Ranebennur from the academic year 1979-80, exclusively meant for Women's education and the college is affiliated to Karnataka State Women's University since 2003-2004

The college was started in small rented building in the city, later it was housed in a high school building. This college was brought into grant-in-aid scheme of government from the academic year 1984. Even after its admission to grant in aid this was running in a high school building up to 1993.

The principal, staff members and managing committee made it possible to acquire independent Infrastructure with their combined efforts as the government sanctioned the institute around 2.38 acres of land in the heart of the city. With this, a major change came up as Construction of first phase completed and the infrastructure ended with the undeterred will and co-operation of management and staff members by 1993. We embarked into the new journey after shifting to new building during the December of year 1993.

Ranebennur being a Semi-urban area, consists of greater number of Backward and Minority communities. And our college managed to attract a greater number of Female students belonging

to Rural areas of the Taluka.

Our college started in the year 1979 and reached 41 years of heritage in the field of higher education, particularly fulfilling the basic need B. A and B. Com courses.

Generations of students have pursued their academic degrees along with outstanding performance and have created themselves an impeccable career in many retrospective fields.

The BAJSS college has created a Jubilant impression in the field of education by providing qualitative level of exposure for students. Not only in Education, but also in Sports, Red cross, Cultural activities, NSS etc., Greater number of students have participated and have received various Medals and Certificates in their respective fields.

Followed by, the college now has greater strength of students comparatively, reaching the benchmark of 450 plus for the academic year 2020-21.

The BAJSS faculties represent a great dedication towards Change. Institution has a friendly atmosphere, to motivate and push our faculties to persuade oneself towards a greater good. As our Motto makes it clear that we intend to Develop the educational quality and most importantly, the mindset of our students towards a positive outlook.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council visited our institution in the month of Sept. 2012, and the peer team had reaccredited our Institute with 'B' Grade on January 2013 considering the remarkable journey and dedication towards Education.



A. REPORT

ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS AT RANEBENNUR RUN BY BAJSS (KARNATAKA STATE BRANCH) :

RANEBENNUR is one among the talukas of Haveri district in Karnataka, which is Geographically happens to be positioned in the central part of Karnataka. It is inevitable to ignore the beautiful weather. This town is known for seed multiplication industries and companies. It is also known for the wholesale cloth market. Good number of SC/STs reside in and around the respective locality which includes tribal community called Banjara Lambani and many other educationally deprived classes. Due to their Socio-economic backwardness BAJSS State Branch decided to improve their Socio-political- Economic situation by opening educational institution in this taluka.

To fulfill the above goals, State Branch of BAJSS decided to start First Grade Women's college at Ranebennur. Dist. Haveri, in the year 1979.

After following due formalities with the Karnatak University. The First-grade college for women was started from academic year 1979-80. Later in the year 2003-2004 was affiliated to Karnataka State Women's University.

The college faced a lot of hurdles during the period of non-grant. The other reason along was the disturbances created by some ill thinking wrested group in Ranebennur.

The college was brought under Grant-In-Aid Scheme from 01-07-1984 and acquired 3 Acres of Government land in the heart of the city but, unfortunately, the total land was covered in deep open pond, connected to local slum drainage outlet. During that time, it was utterly impossible to make use of the land for the educational Institution.

However, the staff and local management committee determined to fill up the pond, cleared drainage waste and constructed a complex along with a building for college on the other side, exclusively meant for education institution run by BAJSS unit at Ranebennur.

Hence, we started construction of building since 1990, the expansion activities have been expanding right from then.

The main building in Ranebennur campus consists of about 25 Rooms and a separate Library, Gymnasium hall, Auditorium, Canteen, Women's Hostel, Toilets, etc. The building consists of ground floor 1st floor and 2nd floor. The total constructed site stands to be about 3000 sq. meters.

During the year 2005, Gayatri samooha has conducted One crore Maha Gayathri Yagna Homa in our college campus. This Kotigayatri homa is one of the historical ceremonies conducted till today in this area. In memory as this Mahayagna, we have named campus as “Shri Gayatri campus”.

Our campus also has separate Hostel for women, which can accommodate 150 female students. The campus consists of:

- One Women's college (Degree).
- One Boys college (Degree).
- One Pre-University college (Plus 2) for women.
- One Pre-University College (Plus 2) Co-education Science.
- Gayatri High School, Ranebennur
- College of Education [B.Ed.]

The total number of students for all these programs is about 2500. The local governing committee BAJSS, has also thought for expanding its educational activities in different places of Ranebennur taluka.

In view of this a Pre-University Independent Junior College was started in the year 1985, in the extension area of Ranebennur, which has Arts, Commerce and Home Science departments for the

benefit of rural students. The above said College is functioning very efficiently to cater the educational needs of many communities, The BAJSS Ranebennur has also started schools and colleges in the rural part of the Taluka, Which are as follows:-

- BAJSS Ramappa Naikar High School at Antravalli village.
- BAJSS Mahatma Bapuji High School at Nittur village.
- BAJSS Shri. Durgamatha High School of Kavalettu village.
- BAJSS Pre-University College (Plus 2) Kavalettu village.
- BAJSS Convent School at Kavalettu village.

Our Educational activities have been expanding day by day from 1979 till date. Few of them are Aided by Government of Karnataka which covers only salary component. We are also proud to mention here that the BAJSS is educating 2 to 3 thousand students every year, which majorly consists of SC/ST and other backward class students of this area.

STAFF:

The educational institution is very particular about the quality of education. For which many programs and activities are conducted every year as promotional activities. In order to provide quality education, the institution has appointed a highly qualified faculty. Teachers, Lectures, Assistant and Associate Professors, who are having highest educational qualifications such as Ph.D. (Doctor of Philosophy), Net (National Eligibility Test), Kset (Karnataka State Eligibility Test), M.Phil. (Master of Philosophy), M. A (Master of Arts), M.Ed. (Master of Education), etc.



STUDENTS:

Nearly 2 to 3 thousand Male and Female students are studying from primary to degree level every year. It is our proud privilege to mention here that, almost 60% of the students belongs to SC/ST and other backward class community from Rural background. The institution has made uniform compulsory.

PLACEMENTS:

Our Degree colleges are known for Qualitative teaching. Also, it is considered to be the top institute in the area of Ranebennur for maintaining Culture and Discipline. This has attracted various National and International companies to visit our campus for placements. Many generations of Final year students have been successfully placed and planted themselves in various Government as well as corporate sectors.

FUNDING AND FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

The institution has put up all efforts to acquire considerable financial assistance from the UGC, HRD, MLCS and MP funds. BAJSS, New Delhi has made considerable amount of contributions, made possible by Public donations in order to acquire land and Infra constructions. The local management has succeeded in fulfilling the financial needs through Bank Loans, including Individual loans to meet growing expansion expenditures.

The BAJSS educational institutions located in Ranebennur have gained tremendous Reputation and Appreciation, by rendering yeoman service by selfless efforts, for its dedication and commitment to uplift SC/STs, Tribal communities and OBCs.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

The Department of Physical education was established in the year 1979. Sports and Athletic activities began right from the beginning of the first Academic year. Our college conducts both Indoor and Outdoor games every year. The department of Sports is well equipped with a 12 stage multi-gym facility. The department encourages the students to participate in University, Inter-university, State and National level tournaments.
